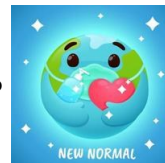

Hi Friends & Neighbors,

What a crazy year. Remember
when we kept saying, "I just want it to get
back to normal." It's been a while, hasn't it?
Do you even remember what normal was?
Me neither.



Now let's add to that weirdness these extreme
temperatures in our region this year. They have caused
some very specific problems in turf at a level I have
never seen before. First, chinch bugs have been really
bad. In some cases, the damage
is bad enough to consider
over-seeding this fall. The other



issue is crabgrass infestations. Crabgrass will need to be
addressed next spring. If
you had crabgrass this year,
the chance of it being back
next year is pretty good.

Both these conditions,
crabgrass and chinch bugs,
are made worse by heat (we've had that), drought (that
one too), and mowing too short. I know I am like a
broken record, but mowing high in the summer really
does make a difference. We had a mow customer fire us
because we would not cut his lawn short. We're pretty
passionate about turf care around here, and we aren't
going to do something that will hurt the health of your
lawn. We are encouraged to see many lawns that have
improved rapidly in just a few days due to a higher mow
height and a couple of days of cooler temps.



Like so many other companies, the labor
shortage has affected us. In fact, for the first time in our
30 year history, we have stopped taking
new customers for this year to ensure
that we can service you, our current and
longtime customers. Thank you so much
for your patience with us. If you have
seen an adorable blonde lawn technician and an old guy,
